in Beijing, China,
on 26 September 2009**

Note: The resolutions were not all taken in the order they are given here because one P-member had to leave early and wanted to cast his vote on issues of particular importance to him. During the acceptance of the resolutions the number of P-members present thus changed from 11 to 10. This explains the differences in the number of votes cast on each resolution.

Graphic technology — Input data for characterization of 4-colour process printing — Part 1: Initial data set

→ Administratively revise this standard in order to replace sub-clause 4.4, and the pointers to it, with a pointer to ISO 28178.

ISO 12647-4

Graphic technology -- Process control for the production of half-tone colour separations, proofs and production prints -- Part 4: Publication gravure printing

→ Revise this standard. The development time frame for the resulting project will be 48 months.
