**Minutes of the 32<sup>st</sup> meeting of the ISO/TC 130/WG 1: Terminology  
21, 23–25 September 2009 in Beijing, China**

**1** The meeting was called to order at 9.00 by Barbara Horn, the convenor.

**3** Approval of the draft agenda (Doc WG 1 N 400)  
The draft agenda was approved.

**4** Approval of the minutes of the last meeting (Doc WG 1 N 398)  
The minutes were approved.

**5** ISO 12637-7 ISO 12637 Graphic Technology – Vocabulary

The stage of preparation for the revision of this standard was explained and discussed. It was confirmed that liaison members from the other WGs in TC 130 have been nominated. Co-project leaders for each of the four parts of the standard were identified at the meeting.

Although it is planned for this revision to be on the ISO Concept Data Base (CDB), the latter is not yet ready, and an interim system has been established (N 404). Mary Lou Pelaprat explained to the WG that the protocols for maintaining a standard on the ISO CDB are stipulated in Annex ST of the Supplement, and the appropriate teams will be confirmed when this information has been absorbed.

A Resolution was proposed to allow this work to begin:

Noting that ISO 12637 (all parts) requires frequent changes and updates, ISO/TC 130 resolves that this standard be transformed into a standard in database format in accordance with Annex ST of the ISO Supplement of the ISO/IEC Directives Part 1. ISO/TC 130 entrusts ISO/TC 130/WG 1 with starting the implementation of this decision.

(This Resolution was subsequently numbered 360 and passed at the Plenary.)

## **6 ISO 5776 Graphic Technology: text proof correction marks (Doc N 402)**

The comments on the second CD were discussed and resolved, resulting in the need to correct format, typographical and illustrative errors. A discussion was initiated with ISO about the technical aspects of making the required changes to the document to overcome the problems in the illustrations. Mary Lou Pelaprat will investigate this matter with the production controller at ISO Central.

A discussion of the draft Table 2 resulted in some symbols being moved to Table 1. The Japanese and Chinese experts held a subcommittee meeting in which they harmonized the remaining symbols in Table 2.

It was agreed that following the implementation of the corrections required by the resolution of the comments and the work on Table 2 and its annexes, the WG would, in accordance with permitted ISO procedures, ask for a short circulation of the CD in the TC, and, if agreed, then proceed to DIS.

(It was subsequently agreed that the expert from Korea would be involved in the final stages of this work, and contact would be established with the relevant expert from Thailand, who was unable to attend the conference.)

**7** Barbara Horn thanked the organisers of the Beijing meeting for the excellent their organization of the conference and meeting facilities, and their gracious hospitality, and thanked the experts for their participation, and declared the meeting closed.
