ISO/TC 130 notes with pleasure that NEN is also willing to perform the secretariat function for the new ISO/TC 130/WG.*

and based on the approved Work Item (ISO/TC 130 N 1683), the Secretariat is pleased to inform you that ISO has provided an area in Livelink for the new established Working Group 10.

The aim of WG 10 is to develop ISO 14298 Graphic Technology - Management of Security Printing Processes.

Based on the comments received (ISO/TC 130 N 1683) the Working Group is requested to discuss besides others the comments/proposal from US to establish a Joint Working Group between ISO/TC 130 (WG10) together with ISO/TC 247 "Fraud countermeasures and controls".

To establish or change a Working Group into a Joint Working Group requires an ISO/TC 130 resolution. The proposal for a resolution should be available for discussion before the Plenary Meeting, held 2010-10-16 in Sao Paulo, Brazil.
