Background

In the revised version of the Resolutions from the Plenary Meeting in Sao Paulo only a footnote to resolution 418 has been added by the secretary. This information refers to the correct status of the liaison (internal Liaison instead A-Liaison).

Resolutions 24th Plenary Meeting, Sao Paulo, Brazil

- 395 ISO/TC130 appoints Dr. David Penfold (UK) as new Convenor of ISO/TC130/WG1.

Unanimous

- 396 ISO/TC 130 thanks Barbara Horn as former Convenor of WG1 for all her effort and the leadership during many years, and specifically for her work on the development of ISO 5776.

Unanimous

- 397 ISO/TC130 resolves to initiate a new work item for the revision of ISO 12643-1 *Graphic technology - Safety requirements for graphic technology equipment and systems - Part 1: General requirements*.

ISO/TC130 requests its secretariat to undertake the steps necessary to implement this resolution.

Abstention: Italy

- 398 ISO/TC130 resolves to divide ISO 15311 *Graphic Technology - Requirements for printed matter utilizing digital printing technologies for the commercial and industrial production*, presently at Stage 0, into multiple parts. The currently identified parts are as follows:
Part 1: Parameters and Measurement Methods
Part 2: Commercial Production Printing
Part 3: Large Format Signage Printing.

The Secretariat is requested to transmit these name changes to ISO/CS.

- 399 ISO/TC 130 resolves to initiate new work item proposals to revise ISO 12647-1, ISO12647-2, and ISO12647-3.

ISO/TC130 requests its secretariat to undertake the steps necessary to implement this resolution.

- 400 ISO/TC 130 resolves to initiate a 3-Month Committee Internal Ballot to confirm National Body agreement with the WG3 proposed withdrawal of ISO 13656. ISO 13656 is technically outdated in many areas and no group or individual has indicated an interest in or willingness to revise this document. A review of the current TC130 International Standards indicates that all references to ISO 13656 are either in informative notes or in bibliographies. However, the Systematic Review result shows that 7 National Bodies indicated that they have adopted this standard at some level.

ISO/TC130 requests its secretariat to undertake the steps necessary to implement this resolution.

- 401 ISO/TC 130 resolves to use CIEDE2000, where appropriate, for all new ISO/TC130 standards and revisions of existing standards.

- 402 ISO/TC 130 resolves to add a preliminary work item (PWI) for the development of an international standard entitled – “*Graphic Technology – Requirements for measuring the carbon footprint of printed products*” at stage 0.

- 404 Because there are no known implementations of ISO 15930-5 (confirmed by a survey of ISO/TC 130 National Bodies), upon recommendation of WG2, ISO/TC130 resolves to withdraw ISO 15930-5.

- 405 ISO/TC130 requests its Secretariat to forward to ISO a Corrigendum to ISO 15930-8 to correct 4 capitalization and spelling errors (in XMP keys and elements) based on a draft document provided by Dave McDowell.

406 ISO/TC130 wishes to note the recent publication of ISO 16612-2, *Graphic technology -- Variable data exchange -- Part 2: Using PDF/X-4 and PDF/X-5 (PDF/VT-1 and PDF/VT-2)* and extend its appreciation to the Convenor Tim Donahue and the members of WG2 TF3 for a difficult job well done.

407 ISO/TC130 resolves to start work in WG 2, at Stage 0, to develop an International Standard for *Preparation and visualization of RGB images to be used in RGB-based graphic arts workflows*.

ISO/TC130 requests its secretariat to undertake the steps necessary to implement this resolution.

408 ISO/TC130 resolves to assign responsibility for ISO 16684-1 to WG2.

409 ISO/TC130 approves the formation of WG2/TF4 which will have the following scope:

- to support the review of comments on ISO 16684-1 and, when approved, complete the preparation of the document for ISO publication,
- to provide ongoing maintenance, support and future development for ISO 16684,
- to identify the XMP vocabularies and file format embedding rules for the graphic arts industry, and
- to develop the necessary ISO standard(s) to document the identified vocabularies and rules.

410 ISO/TC130 resolves to accept the invitation of ISO/TC42 to join with TC42 in a TC42 led JWG for the development of an International Standard (ISO 12234-3) describing the photographic applications of XMP based on ISO 16684-1.

411 Upon recommendation of WG4, ISO/TC130 resolves to reaffirm ISO 2846-2.

Unanimous

412 Upon recommendation of WG4, ISO/TC130 resolves to revise ISO 2834-2 to incorporate inkfilm thickness determinations.

The secretariat is requested to take the actions necessary.

- 413 ISO/TC130 resolves to initiate work, at Stage 0, to create a standards document(s) under the following title: *Graphic Technology - Criteria and Requirements for Printing Quality Management Systems*. This work to be done in a new Working Group, Printing Certification Requirements, is to be convened by Professor Robert Chung. Secretariat support will be provided by Brazil.
